## Timber Procurement Policy

LaROCK Construction Ltd operates in four divisions, construction, development, joinery solutions and design. LaROCK Construction Ltd combines complete project and cost management with innovation and an extremely high level of service for all clients. As part of the company commitment to continuous improvement in environmental performance, we seek to procure our timber and timber products from well managed, sustainable and legal sources.

To achieve this we will ensure the following:

- That all timber used in our projects is from certified sources where possible
- On a global scale we will look to purchase timber from suppliers who have accreditation from the Forestry Stewardship Council (FSC)
- On a European scale we will look to purchase timber from suppliers with European Forest Certification (PEFC)
- Other schemes such as the Nordic Forest Certification and the African Timber organisation will also be recognised
- When it becomes available timber certified under the EU Forest Law Enforcement Governance and Trade (FLEGT) scheme will also be recognised

This policy applies to all employees, sites and any contractors who may work for the company.


This policy will be communicated at induction, on notice boards and is available to the public.
